



Financial Strategy

According to the best available research, it typically takes three to five years for a successful church plant to become financially self-supporting. We are committed to good stewardship, high levels of accountability, and prayerful dependence upon the Lord in order to raise three years of necessary funding.

In coordination with our sending church, we are raising funds via the SEND Network for church planting, other church partners, our launch team, and other individual supporters. The proposed budget will allow us to rent a location for our weekend gatherings, resource appropriate ministries, actively care for our neighborhoods, purchase practical equipment, and fund missional engagements that will imbue gospel multiplication and deep discipleship into the DNA of this new church.

Our sending church and their elders will be providing the financial oversight of our budget and finances. As of now, \$100,000 of the funds have been donated over a period of 4 years. We have every intention of stewarding the time, energy, and resources in ways that are above reproach and honoring to the God. LifePoint Church is a 501(c)3 organization and all donations are tax-deductible.
